While only 600 students are required to present their results to the class, attendance on both days is mandatory as a portion of the presentation grade will be by peer review.

- You will be expected to provide slides **before class**
 - Email/Upload ahead of time or show up early
- Presentations are limited to 10 minutes (2 minutes for questions)
 - This is not a lot of time. You will need to think carefully about prioritizing what to show to the class.
- As in the written portion, you should include
 - Brief introduction to event
 - Synoptic Discussion of Event
 - Conclusion (and presentation of your Conceptual Model)
- Suggestions/Things to keep in mind
 - Have hypothesis and conceptual model in mind in deciding what to present
 - Place emphasis on describing why something happened more so than just stating what happened
 - Tie things into material from class
 - Describe what makes this event unique
